#### Have Your Say: Future Transport in the New England and North West

At the December 2024 Ordinary Council meeting, Council acknowledged its commitment to advocating for improvements to public transport across the region and encourages residents to provide input on two significant initiatives led by Transport for NSW (TfNSW).

TfNSW is in the process of developing the New England and North West Strategic Regional Integrated Transport Plan, which aims to address the region's unique transport needs, with a focus on infrastructure and service improvements. The plan is expected to be finalised by 2026, and prior to this, residents are invited to contribute their feedback.

In addition, TfNSW is proposing changes to the NSW TrainLink Coach services in the North West, informed by passenger feedback. These proposed changes will introduce more efficient routes, new stops and improved travel times, and are also slated to take effect in 2026.

Both initiatives are open for community feedback through the <u>TfNSW Have Your Say portal</u> or via email at engage.sritps@transport.nsw.gov.au. This is an important opportunity for residents to influence the future of public transport in the New England and North West region.

# Additional \$600k Funding Approved for ANZAC Park Playground

Council is pleased to announce the progression of the ANZAC Park Playground Upgrade, with an additional \$600,000 secured through Round 2 of the Australian Government's Growing Regions Program. This funding builds on the \$500,000 obtained from the NSW Government's Stronger Country Communities Fund and the \$100,000 committed by the Council, bringing the total investment to \$1.2 million.

The upgrade will replace the existing playground, which no longer meets the growing demand for modern, accessible, and inclusive recreational spaces. The new playground will be designed for families and individuals of all ages and abilities, responding to feedback from the community, including a petition from local parents.

Community consultation will begin in early February 2025, with residents invited to provide feedback on the proposed design options for the new playground. Construction will commence following the consultation period.

#### **Infrastructure Works Program**

The following works are scheduled in the period ending Friday, 7 February subject to weather conditions and unforeseen delays:

- Jet patching in Glen Innes Township, Old Grafton Road and Maybole Road
- The Roads Construction Crew will be working at the Glen Innes Airport
- Maintenance grading is scheduled Nutrition Station Road, Smiths Road, Shannon Vale Road, Skeleton Creek Road, Browns Road, Ten Mile Road (Morven end) and Glen Elgin Road
- The Bridge Team is working on Coxs Road
- The Drainage Team is working at the Glen Innes Airport
- The Heavy Patching Crew will be undertaking urban heavy patching at various locations as part of the urban heavy patching reseal program
