Australia's Toughest One-Day Cycling Race Returns to Glen Innes

Glen Innes will be at the heart of the action as the <u>Grafton to Inverell Cycle Classic</u> races through town on Saturday, 15 March 2025. Spectators can line Grey Street to experience elite cycling up close, support local businesses and soak up the vibrant atmosphere.

Renowned as one of Australia's toughest road races, this 229km challenge has a history of attracting top riders, including Olympians and Tour de France competitors. This year, Glen Innes plays a key role in the event, with a sprint point near the Australian Standing Stones and a Feed Station supported by local volunteers.

The best viewing spot will be on the western side of Grey Street, between Wentworth and Meade Streets, with riders passing through between 9:15 AM and 2:00 PM. Spectators can also follow the race live on StarFM and catch SBS coverage on Sunday, 16 March, from 1pm to 4pm.
