Temporary Road Closure: Grey Street - 1 and 2 February

As part of the Glen Innes Town Centre Beautification Project, parts of Grey Street will be temporarily closed to allow for garden bed excavation. The closures will occur as follows:

Saturday, 1 February (11am to 5pm):

Grey Street will be closed between Bourke Street and Meade Street (LJ Hooker corner) for all traffic and pedestrians.

Sunday, 2 February (7am to 5pm):

Grey Street will be closed between Bourke Street / Meade Street and Bourke Street / East Avenue (Timbs Pharmacy corner) for all traffic and pedestrians.
