# Blue Green Algae & Town Water Supply Update

Council is working to address the blue-green algae issue by repairing the water mixer that helps keep the water moving. We are also looking into options to improve conditions in the river below the Beardy Waters Weir. The red alert from WaterNSW is still in place.

Council also wishes to advise that the Glen Innes Severn Local Government Area (LGA) remains on permanent Level 1 water restrictions as part of Council's Drought Management Plan, with supply levels continuously monitored. The Beardy Waters Weir is currently at 290mm, and Level 2 restrictions will be implemented if it reaches 500mm.

Further updates will be provided if Level 2 restrictions need to be put in place.

## Infrastructure Works Program

The following works are scheduled in the period ending Friday, 21 February subject to weather conditions and unforeseen delays:

- Jet patching in Glen Innes Township
- The Roads Construction Crew will be working at the Glen Innes Airport
- Maintenance grading is scheduled Shannon Vale Road, Skeleton Creek Road, Browns Road, Glen Elgin Road, Oakey Road and Leamons Road
- The Bridge Team is working on Coxs Road
- The Drainage Team is working at the Glen Innes Airport and Ten Mile Road:
- The Heavy Patching Crew will be undertaking urban heavy patching at various locations as part of the urban heavy patching reseal program.
